1. Position title:

Designated professor (non-faculty member)

2. Number of positions:

One position

3. Contract term:

Until 31 March, 2018

4. Content of duties:

- (1) Organizing lectures, seminars, and international symposia at the Nagoya University Graduate School of Humanities Research Center for Cultural Heritage and Texts (CHT), with the aim of internationalizing research and education at our school.
- (2) Other administrative duties, as deemed necessary.

5. Qualifications:

- (1) Applicants should have a substantial record of research and teaching at an institution of higher learning, either in Japan or abroad.
- (2) Applicants must have a Ph.D. in hand at time of appointment.
- (3) Applicants are expected to have an outstanding publication record in the area of classical or medieval Japanese religious thought.
- (4) Applicants must have citizenship in a country other than Japan.
